COMPETITION GUIDELINES

- 1. ALL communication with the event chairmen MUST BE through the Teacher. <u>There is to be no contact between parents and DMTA chairs.</u>
- ANY Teacher may enter students in the Symphonic Festival Competition. Teachers who are NON-DMTA members should contact <u>emily@musicsosimple.com</u> with first and last name and instrument taught, to receive a temporary username and password. Non-DMTA teachers will pay the non-member enrollment fee.
- 3. ALL entries must be **PAID ONLINE**. Registration fees are **NON-REFUNDABLE**. **ENTER STUDENTS CAREFULLY – no changes will be made after registration closes!**
- Monitoring: ALL Teachers enrolling students in the competition are required to serve as a monitor on the day of the contest.
 Substitute monitors are available for a fee and are listed on the DMTA website.
- 5. Eligibility: the SCHOOL GRADE of the student as of September 1, 2024 will determine what Category they may enter. The student's birth date and school grade MUST be entered at registration.
- 6. Each student is allowed ONE entry in a Division (Piano, String, Wind, Vocal).
- 7. The Vocal Division must have a minimum of 5 entries to be open for competition.
- 8. Contest pieces must be performed by memory.
- 9. Contestants must provide their own accompanist.
- 10. Each contestant must provide music for the judge. *Photocopies are not accepted!* Digital music must have either the teacher's name or the student's name, along with the granted permission, printed at the bottom of the cover page.
- 11. There will be NO finals for any category.
- All 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place trophies will be presented at the Gala event. All 4th, 5th, 6th and Honorable Mention ribbons will be presented the day of the competition.
- 1st place winners are NOT eligible to enter a Category in which they have previously won.
 It is the responsibility of the teacher to make sure this guideline is followed. A student will be disqualified if they place in a category they won in the previous year.
- 14. The First Place Winner of each SENIOR CATEGORY will perform at the Gala. Winners MUST perform in order to receive the monetary award.
- 15. The use of cameras or recording/video equipment is not permitted during any phase of the competition and could result in disqualification.
- 16. Judges' decisions are FINAL, and the Judge reserves the right to declare 'No Winner.'
