COMPETITION GUIDELINES

1. ANY Teacher may enter students in the Symphonic Festival competition. Teachers who are NOT DMTA members should contact faron.vassen@icloud.com, with first and last name and instrument taught, to receive a username and password. Non-DMTA teachers will pay the non-member enrollment fee.
2. ALL DMTA Teachers enrolling students in the competition are required to serve as a monitor on the day of the contest in which their student(s) are registered. Substitute monitors are available for a fee and are listed on the website.
3. Eligibility: the SCHOOL GRADE of the student as of September 1, 2019 will determine what Category they may enter. The student's birth date and school grade MUST be entered at registration.
4. Each student is allowed ONE entry in a Division.
5. Contest pieces must be performed by memory.
6. Contestants must provide their own accompanist.
7. Each contestant must provide music for the judge. Photocopies are not accepted for any reason.
8. There will be NO finals for any category.
9. **All 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place trophies will be presented at the Gala on February 8, 2020 at The Marshall Family Performing Arts Center, Greenhill School. 4th, 5th, 6th and Honorable Mention ribbons will be presented the day of the competition.**
10. All Elementary, Intermediate, and Junior 1st place winners will perform their repertoire on the day of the competition. Audiences are invited to the awards announcements and winner's performance.
11. **The FIRST PLACE WINNER of each Senior Category will perform at the Symphonic Festival Gala. Winners MUST perform in order to receive the monetary award.**
12. 1st place winners are NOT eligible to enter a Category in which they have previously won.
13. The use of cameras or recording/video equipment is not permitted during any phase of the competition and could result in disqualification.
14. Judges' decisions are FINAL and the Judges reserve the right to declare 'No Winner.'
