## Stretto Piano Recital Sunday, May 26 at 2:30 PM in Caruth Auditorium Free Admission

DMTA members and their students are cordially invited to a piano recital featuring Dr. Carol Leone and four SMU graduate students performing on the Steinway D that has been fitted with narrower keys. Afterwards, you and your students are invited to try out the piano and ask questions of Dr. Leone and the SMU students.

This concert is part of the *Fourth International Stretto Piano Festival* in which dozens of pianists performing on pianos with narrow (stretto) keys are giving in-person, live streamed, and pre-recorded performances from stages, universities, private studios, and homes from around the globe from May 25-June 4, 2024.

Participants have opportunities to attend special master classes, numerous student and faculty performances and gain additional solo and chamber music performance experience in a nurturing, artistic, invigorating and fun environment dedicated to classical music.

All participating instrumentalists are eligible to try out for the concerto competition. Concerto competition winners perform with the festival orchestra at the end of each session!

I would also like to point out that this program presents a rare opportunity to our pre-collegiate pianists to develop their skills in collaborative repertoire, working on and performing major works in piano duo and chamber music, with fellow musicians in their age group and level of expertise.

Our internationally acclaimed faculty and guest artists are excited to welcome you to the newly renovated facilities of the UNT College of Music for two weeks of intensive learning and music-making in Denton, TX.
