COMPETITION GUIDELINES

- 1. ALL communication with the event chairmen MUST BE through the DMTA teacher. There is to be no contact between parents and DMTA chairs.
- Any TEACHER may enter students in the Symphonic Festival competition. Teachers who are NOT DMTA members should contact <u>benquine@gmail.com</u>, with first and last name (Teacher's name) and instrument taught, to receive a temporary username and password. Non-DMTA teachers will pay the non-member enrollment fee.
- 3. ALL entries must be registered and paid online.
- 4. Monitoring: ALL Teachers enrolling students in the competition are required to serve as a monitor on the day of the contest.
 - Substitute monitors are available for a fee and are listed on the DMTA website.
- Eligibility: the SCHOOL GRADE of the student as of September 1, 2021 will determine what Category they may enter. The student's birth date and school grade MUST be entered at registration.
- 6. Each student is allowed ONE entry in a Division.
- 7. Contest pieces must be performed by memory.
- 8. Contestants must provide their own accompanist.
- Each contestant must provide music for the judge. Photocopies are not accepted for any reason.
- 10. There will be NO finals for any category.
- 11. <u>IF THE FESTIVAL GALA IS SCHEDULED THIS YEAR</u>, the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place trophies will be presented at the Gala event. If the Gala is not scheduled this year, then the trophies will be presented on the competition day.
 - All 4th, 5th, 6th and Honorable Mention ribbons will be presented the day of the competition.
- IF THE COVID SITUATION ALLOWS All Elementary, Intermediate, and Junior 1st place
 Winners will perform their repertoire on the day of the competition. Audiences will be
 invited to the awards announcements and winners' performances.
- IF THE FESTIVAL GALA IS SCHEDULED THIS YEAR, the FIRST PLACE WINNER of each Senior Category will perform at the Gala. Winners MUST perform in order to receive the monetary award
 - 1st place winners are NOT eligible to enter a Category in which they have previously won.
- 14. The use of cameras or recording/video equipment is not permitted during any phase of the Competition and could result in disqualification.
- 15. Judges' decisions are FINAL, and the Judge reserves the right to declare 'No Winner.'
